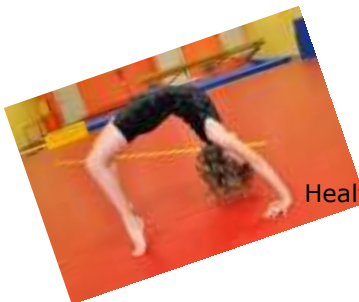

RULES and REGULATIONS

Registration Policy– All campers must pay a one time \$25 registration fee before attending his/her first week of summer camp.

Payment Policy

Acceptable forms of payment are cash, checks or money orders made payable to M.A.D.E. Today. Parents and Guardians who intend to pay by check must complete a check information form.

100% of the weekly fee must be paid by the Wednesday before your child is scheduled to attend summer camp. There is a \$10 late fee payment if received after 6:00pm that Wednesday before your child is scheduled to attend summer camp.

Children picked-up after 6:00pm will be charged a \$10 late fee. This fee must be paid before attending the following day of returning to camp.

Bounced Check policy- If a Parent bounces a check there will be a \$25 fee. The Parent will receive a verbal and/or written notice that their check bounced and the check will be re-submitted within 14 days. Parent's account will become cash only if there has been two consecutive bounced checks.

Bounced checks which remain unresolved for sixty days will be forwarded to collections for immediate legal action.

Students will not be allowed to attend summer camp or any other M.A.D.E. sessions until all accounts are settled.

All summer camp fees and payments are non-refundable.

Spectators Policy- Parents and/or siblings or guests are welcomed to visit but must sign in between the hours of 10:00am-4:00pm with M.A.D.E. summer camp staff.

Camp Attire Policy – Students must wear comfortable clothing suitable for play and practice. Sneakers are a must. No sandals or open-toed shoes permitted on grounds. Female campers must purchase a T-shirt and shorts (\$20) during their first week of camp.

Absentee Policy- Refunds are not given for any reason during the week in which you have previously paid full-price for.

Daily Attendance Policy- Available for campers in which will like to attend summer camp daily or a limited amount of days a specific week. The cost for attending daily is \$25/day.

Photo Release- Parents hereby give permission, without limitation or obligation, for the Student to be photographed or videotaped in relation to their participation at class or programs. Photographs and videotape may be used for archival or promotional purposes.

Indemnification and Liability

Parents give permission for campers to participate in summer camp for which he/she will be registered.

Parents are aware of the risks involved, assume all risks for Campers' participation in the Summer Camp and do hereby release, indemnify and hold harmless M.A.D.E. Today, Inc. its organizers, sponsors, administrators and instructors from and against any and all liability of any nature whatsoever arising out of, incident to or in any way connected with the Camper's participation in the Summer Camp.
